DIRECTIONS AND LOCATION INFO:

Located 10 miles north of I-90 near Logan, MT at Headwaters Hops.

Take I90 to Exit 283 (Logan exit). Turn north off the interstate exit at the stop sign (if heading east on the interstate, turn left, if heading west on the interstate, turn right) then at the stop sign turn left (W) onto the Frontage Road. Take the next right (N) onto the Logan-Trident Road that crosses the Gallatin River. Continue on the pavement, (merging onto Clarkston Road in 4 miles), for a total of 10 miles. Turn right at the mailbox and sign for Headwaters Hops (HH), just past mile marker 10. **WATCH FOR THE 10 MILE MARKER**, our driveway will sneak up on you.

The office is located on the left, just past the cabins. **Please stop in at the office upon your first visit** for directions to parking. There is ample space for horse trailers.

There is little or no cell reception here at the ranch. Nearest services are 14 miles, so come in with plenty of fuel. Please, no dogs. We ask you to remove all hay and manure from the areas around your trailers and your pens. Water is available for your horse, bring your own buckets.

WE ARE THRILLED TO ASK YOU TO “Please excuse the mess!” We are in the middle of massive construction here, including kennels, stall shed, tack barn, arena and corrals, Clubhouse, Round Barn, new cabins, and lots of landscaping and completion of the Headwaters Hops Cross Country Course. The horse/hound facility should be completed by October, and The Round Barn at Headwaters Hops is open in Spring of 2018.

We will be utilizing a practice field with standard practice jumps, portions of the Headwaters Hops Cross Country Course, and Big Sky Hounds hunt country full of typical hunt terrain in Montana.

TACK AND ATTIRE - Horse and Rider

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Typical August weather is hot and sunny in the daytime, cool at night. It is dry and dusty here. Please bring suitable tack and clothing to be comfortable all day outside in extreme weather. Also, be prepared for rain (we can only hope). Horses should be shod, as our cross country terrain has rough footing.

We recommend helmets.

Sunday BSH Meet attire is casual, as it is during our informal/conditioning season. Breeches and white polos, or jeans and white shirts acceptable. Cubbing attire is also appropriate, if convenient.

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Acknowledgement of Risk and Assumption of Liability

I/we request permission to participate in cross-country horseback riding, use of jumps and courses, fox hunting, and other horseback or ranch activities with Montana Horses Inc. and Big Sky Hounds. I/we fully understand that cross country horseback riding, backcountry trail riding, fox hunting, and other related activities **ARE VERY DANGEROUS ACTIVITIES** that include riding unsupervised at all gaits, over fences, other obstacles, and on difficult, steep, uneven and rough, rocky, slick, and icy terrain, in various weather conditions that are often inclement, and in remote locations without emergency services or telephone/communication. I understand that I am riding or participating at my own risk and acknowledge that my participation in this activity could result in **INJURY OR DEATH**. I/We acknowledge and understand the risks of injury or death to me/us or my/our property.

I understand that I will be riding with or in close proximity to other people, with other horses, around others property, around ATVS, and around animals like hounds, dogs, livestock, and wild animals. I understand that people, horses, and other animals might act unpredictably and in a manner that could cause **INJURY OR DEATH** to me/us, my horse(s), and my property.
